## Parents' Guide - Workshop 12 Colours of the World

### Using Worksheet 12

### **AIM:**

- To practice fine motor dexterity, and to have fun using imagination in choosing outfits for Trixie.

### **Instructions:**

1. Print all five pages on a colour printer.
2. Cut out the Trixie doll and the plain doll – AND all the outfits and hairstyles.
3. Don't forget to cut around the tags!
4. Add hair and clothes to the doll by folding tabs around the back of the doll.
5. For sturdier dolls, use a heavier paper, card, photo paper or printable magnetic paper (available at office supply stores). However do not be put off if you do not have the above – this activity works well with plain A4 paper too.
6. Use your imagination to mix and match outfits and hair.
